K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

Instructions for VF8002- Engine compartment

1. Open the hood and locate the cabin filter housing on the passenger side cowl. Fig. 1
2. Detach the grill retaining clips on both sides and remove the plastic grill that covers the cabin filter housing. Fig. 2
3. Lift the flap, remove the dirty cabin filter and any debris that might be present inside the housing slot. Fig. 3
4. Install the K&N® cabin air filter with the text "THIS SIDE UP" facing out. Fig. 4
5. Reverse steps 1-2 to complete the cabin air filter installation. With the K&N® cabin filter installed, clean an area and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.

Instructions for VF8003- Bunk

1. Depending on the sleeper configuration, lift the lower bunk bed mattress or passenger side lower couch cushion to access the bunk heater box. Fig. 5 & Fig. 6
2. Remove the dirty cabin air filter and any debris that might be present inside the housing slot. Fig. 7
3. Install the K&N® cabin air filter. Fig. 8
4. Reverse step 1 to complete the cabin filter installation. With the K&N® cabin filter installed, clean an area and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.
